



# IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SCRUTINEERING FOR THE 2012 CLUB MARINE SOUTHERN 80.

Please note ALL boats competing in the 2012 CLUB MARINE SOUTHERN 80 will need to be re-scrutineered regardless of exemption. This is a NSW Maritime condition of Aquatic Licence. Boats may be scrutineered up to 2 weeks prior to the race when MWSC make available via their web site the scrutineering form. This form will have a Southern 80 water mark on it and is the only form acceptable. Please NOTE you must have your boat scrutineered AFTER your last event and prior to the Southern 80. Forms will be available on website from Friday 27<sup>th</sup> January 2012. If you are racing on the long weekend you must get your boat scrutineered after this event. You can simply visit an SRA scrutineer at a time that suits or present your boat at Echuca on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> February as per normal. Every boat owner is to hand in a scrutineering form to the girls on Friday at the office.

This also includes a fresh rudder crack test report. Rudders must be crack tested on or after 16/1/12, or as mentioned earlier, after your last race. This puts it after the Nationals but allows 3 weeks to have it done. The new crack test must be sited by the scrutineer and handed in to MWSC at registration.

THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS TO THESE CONDITIONS OF ENTRY.
