Rule 14.5 - In Australian Speed & Marathon Championships a skier may nominate in his or her age division, Open, Social Men or Women and one Engine class only. This means an individual skier may compete in 3 speed events. A skier may nominate in one marathon class (ie. Age or Open). A boat may enter more than one engine class.

ENTRIES

All entries are to be on the official 2012 entry form and payment must be included with all entries. A separate entry form must be completed for each event entered. Entries close at 5pm Friday 9th December 2011. Late entries will be accepted up to 4pm on Monday 9th January 2012. A late entry fee of 50% of the full entry fee will apply. All late entries will be placed on the outside of the draw. Members should be conversant with Section 16 of the SRA Rule Book. All participants in ski racing events shall be SRA members with correct dues paid. If you have not joined SRA a minimum of one week prior to your first event then you will not be allowed to compete in that event. Three weeks prior to an event is required if a GPS setup is needed.

Rule 14.8 - Any competitor wishing to enter the Australian Speed and Marathon Championships must have competed in major sanctioned State event or a State Ski Racing Championship.

Rule 14.5 - In Australian Speed & Marathon Championships a skier may nominate in his or her age division, Open, Social Men or Women and one Engine class only.

Entry fees will be \$150 per event except Under 13's - \$75 and Under 10's free. Entries will not be deemed accepted until clearance of cheques & credit card payments. Cheques are to be made payable to Ski Racing Australia. Credit card payments will be accepted with 5% transaction levy added to the entry fee. Direct deposits can be made to SRA Nationals Account, BSB 082-906 A/C No 59-481-8503 . Please ensure a copy of the transfer receipt is sent with your entry form. **The SRA insurance boat levy of \$25.00 must be paid at scrutineering or with your entry.**

BOAT NUMBERS

Where possible your preferred race number will be allocated. If duplications occur one of the boats will be asked to display an alternative number which shall be allocated after the entries have closed. If this is to occur, the boat owner will be notified of the alternate number. Please refer to SRA rule 7.31 'official race numbers' to ensure that your boat number is legal.

DOCUMENTATION

If either your Waterways Licence or Boat Registration has expired since the issue of your 2011/2012 SRA card please supply a photocopy of receipt of renewal.

BRIEFING

Briefing for all events will be held at the Barmera Monash Football Club, 150 Dean Drive, Barmera on Monday 9th January 2012. The time of the briefing will be notified to all boat owners upon acceptance of your entry. A briefing sheet will be available for all who attend this briefing. Drivers and observers will be required to sign **in and out.**

PRACTICE

There will be no official practice.

COMPULSORY SAFETY SCRUTINEERING

Compulsory safety scrutineering will take place on Monday 9th January 2012 at Barmera Football Oval from 11:00am until 4:00pm. **The SRA insurance boat levy of \$25.00 must be paid at scrutineering or with your entry.** This levy will cover the boat for the whole week. It is recommended that skiers gear will be presented at the boat scrutineering for checking with your boat.

FUEL

Avgas - competitors will need to arrange their own avgas. Refuelling will only be allowed in the designated area. There will be no refueling in the water. Anyone found breaching this will be Disqualified for the remainder of the championships. Full instructions on refueling will be included in the briefing sheet. SPECIAL NOTE: You are required to carry enough fuel to complete 2 races. If you are in consecutive races you will not be allowed time to refuel.

PRESENTATION

Presentation will be held on Friday 13th January. Details will be advised.

SATURDAY 14TH JANUARY will be a layover day. In case of delays to racing events will be held on this day.
